

## **Level I Fieldwork (C) Learning Objectives**

At the completion of this course, the successful occupational therapy (OT) student will be able to:

1. Apply knowledge of HIPAA guidelines, the AOTA code of ethics, and the Standards of Practice in OT in the context of the Fieldwork site.
2. Demonstrate sound judgement regarding safety of self and others and adhere to Fieldwork site safety regulations.
3. Demonstrate appropriate professional behaviors: time management, organization, self-directed learning, communication, and use of professional terminology.
4. Justify the role and purpose of OT in the context of the Fieldwork site.
5. Explain the process of collaboration with the client during evaluation and treatment in the context of the Fieldwork site.
6. Explain the interprofessional team at the Fieldwork site and summarize the impact it has on the client's treatment. If there is no interprofessional team, explain what team members would be appropriate in this setting and what the potential benefits to the client would be.
7. Identify psychosocial factors for the client and/or population at the Fieldwork site and recommend interventions that directly, or indirectly, address those factors.
