### Creating an Account

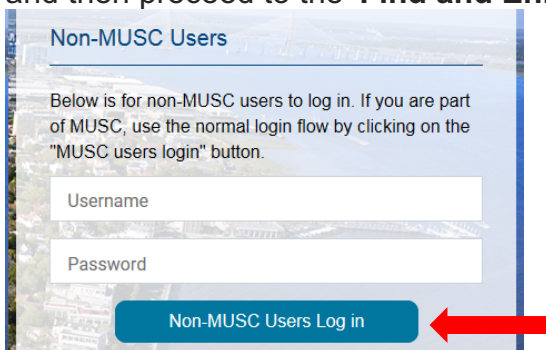
1. Navigate to the Harbor home page by typing in the URL <https://musc.mrooms3.net/>.

Please note: If you already have an account in Harbor, then you can login using your username and password.

- If you are an MUSC user then please select the “MUSC Users Login” on the left side of the webpage and enter your MUSC credentials via the secured login system and then proceed to the ‘**Find and Enroll in Course**’ section in instructions below.




- If you are a Harbor account holder as a non-MUSC user, then enter your Harbor profile username and password in the ‘Non-MUSC Users’ login on the right side of the webpage and then proceed to the ‘**Find and Enroll in Course**’ section in instructions below.



- If you do not have an account in Harbor, proceed to Step 2 to create a new account.

2. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click on the button to “Create new account”.

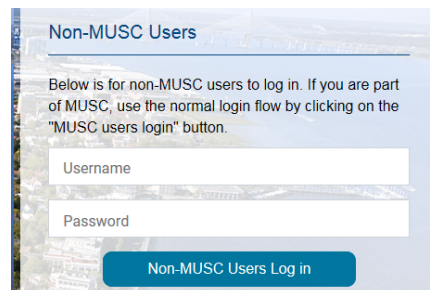
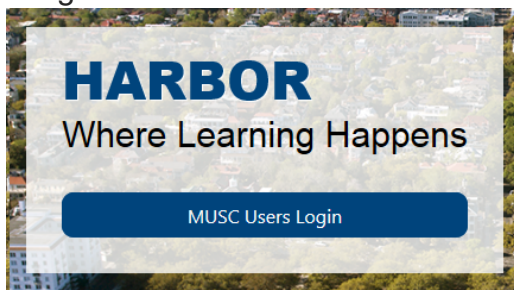
