Required - Activate your MUSC NetID: By April 1, you will receive an email including MUSC NetID activation instructions. Your MUSC NetID will allow you to access your MUSC email account, Learning Management System (Brightspace), the MUSC Student Portal, and several other student systems and resources. If you were issued an MUSC NetID in the past, please notify Brittany Guthrie, guthrieb@musc.edu, as this may delay your activation email.	Personal Email	ASAP following receipt of NetID on April 1
Required - Send in your Final Transcripts: If your admission offer is contingent on completing a degree or prerequisite courses, be sure to request that your final, official transcripts be sent to MUSC. Transcripts must be sent directly from your institution. Electronic transcripts can be emailed to <a href="mailto:oesadmis@musc.edu">oesadmis@musc.edu</a> or submitted through Parchment. Required - Review and Meet Immunization Requirements: Review the Mandatory Immunization Requirements Form and collect your applicable medical records. You must upload your completed form and documentation to the MUSC Student Portal. More information about the Student Portal will follow. We recommend you begin working on the documentation of your immunizations early. Please note that Hepatitis B immunity is a requirement and can take several weeks to several months. Required - Complete American Heart Association (AHA) Basic Life Support (BLS) Certification: If you do not already have this certification, sign up for a training course soon. This must be complete prior to the fall semester and only the American Heart Association training will be accepted. You may complete either the Blended Learning course or the Classroom course.
